



Glassboro High School Scholars Program

Each year, Glassboro High School graduates extremely well-prepared students who have achieved academic distinction. Some choose to further their education at Rowan University, but far too many of these bright students leave the area. Rowan University is committed to reversing this trend by sponsoring the **Glassboro High School Scholars Program (GHSSP)**, allowing Glassboro public school students to take advantage of a public university education at one of the finest institutions in the State of New Jersey.

Graduating seniors from Glassboro High School class of 2008 who meet the following criteria will be eligible to receive one of three annual Glassboro High School Scholarships:

- SAT score of 1300 or higher (Math and Critical Reading combined only)
- Minimum 3.0 GPA during each semester of junior and senior years
- Top 10% rank of graduating class
- Demonstrated leadership characteristics
- Evidence of service to the community.

If more than three students apply, the scholarships will be awarded competitively to the applicants best matching the above criteria.

As an added incentive, students meeting these criteria also qualify for the **Rowan University Scholars Program**. In all, each **Glassboro High School Scholar** will receive enough funds to cover tuition, fees, room and board for a full-time undergraduate student who chooses to live on campus. This amount will be adjusted accordingly if the student chooses not to live on campus.

Students wishing to be considered for the **Glassboro High School Scholars Program** must first submit an application for admission to Rowan University as early as possible, and submit the **GHSSP** application with required documentation by February 15. Students will be notified of a decision by April 1.
