The Post-Baccalaureate Certification Program is a non-degree program designed for students who hold bachelor's degrees and are seeking the appropriate teaching certifications necessary for working in the public school system.

It is an undergraduate level program, so undergraduate, per credit tuition and fees apply.

All candidates for admission must complete the application and return it to The Graduate School with a check or money order for the non-refundable \$50 application fee. Applicants are responsible for having official transcripts from each institution they have attended forwarded to The Graduate School address above. Applicants who are graduates of Rowan University are not required to request transcripts unless they have attended another institution after they graduated. Official transcripts are usually sent directly from the issuing institution or agency in a sealed envelope, are recently dated, bear an authorized signature, and are printed on security paper or embossed with the institution's seal. Students who attended a college or university outside the U.S. are required to have a course-by-course evaluation of their academic credentials performed by the World Education Service at their own expense. Individual programs may have additional application requirements; these are noted on the programs list on the reverse side. A bachelor's degree and a minimum, overall undergraduate grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 are required for admission to the Post-Baccalaureate Certification Program.

Applicants to teacher certification programs should have strong academic backgrounds in the liberal arts and sciences, including at least sixty (60) semester hours in general education studies. In addition to the cumulative GPA requirement noted above, a minimum average of 3.0 in course work related to the certification area is required. Applicants requesting admittance to instructional certification programs must also supply official passing Praxis I scores for the areas of Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. Programs leading to instructional certificates are marked by asterisk (*) on the program list. Information concerning the Praxis is available from the Educational Testing Service. **If you currently hold a New Jersey teaching certificate in any area, please include a copy of the certificate with your application.**

Due to a limited number of openings, admission to post-baccalaureate programs is competitive. Thus, meeting the basic admission requirements does not guarantee acceptance. No admission review or credit evaluation will be done before the application is considered complete by The Graduate School. In order to be reviewed for a particular semester, all required materials must be received in The Graduate School by the semester's designated deadline.

Incomplete applications are held active for only two semesters-the semester for which the candidate originally applied and its subsequent semester. If the applicant's records are regarded incomplete on the second semester's deadline date, the application will be withdrawn.
