APPLIED SPANISH PROGRAM SEQUENCE A

The Bachelor's of Art in Liberal Studies: Humanities/Social Science is designed to offer students the opportunity to specialize in multiple areas of study in the humanities and social sciences. The ability to combine diverse areas of interest is highly desired by traditional as well as non-traditional students to enrich their lives and prepare for productive and rewarding careers. In place of one concentrated major, courses are to be completed in two program areas by choosing one Program Sequence A and one Program Sequence B **OR** two Program A Sequences.

The "Applied Spanish Language Program Sequence A" provides students with a general background for future professional studies and advanced degrees in Spanish. Students who complete the Applied Spanish Sequence may work in a wide variety of fields, including social, administrative and governmental work, as well as in international business.

In order to satisfy the sequence requirements, students must take at least 18 to 21 credits, depending upon previously-completed prerequisites and/or Spanish Placement Exam results. Those students wishing to start the program without having completed the prerequisite course, Spanish III (SPAN 05.201), must take the Spanish Placement Exam; for more information, contact Dr. Marilyn Manley at manley@rowan.edu. Students may transfer in up to 6 credits in fulfillment of the program sequence*.

Required courses:

All courses must be passed with a letter grade of "C-" or better and no courses may be taken Pass/No Credit (P/NC.)

Introductory Level Courses (3-6 credits):

Spanish Reading and Conversation (SPAN 05.211) (pre-requisite SPAN 05.201 or placement exam results)
Spanish Reading and Composition (SPAN 05.212) (pre-requisite SPAN 05.211 or placement exam results)

Advanced Level Courses (12 credits):

Choose four of the following:

- Oral Spanish (SPAN 05.305).....(prerequisite SPAN 05.211 or placement exam results)
- Spanish Phonetics (SPAN 05.300)..... (prerequisite SPAN 05.212)
- Spanish for Business (SPAN 05.312)(prerequisite SPAN 05.212)
- Spanish for Medical Personnel (SPAN 05.313)(prerequisite SPAN 05.212)
- Introduction to Spanish Translation (SPAN 05.340)(prerequisite SPAN 05.212)
- Advanced Spanish Conversation (SPAN 05.411)(prerequisite SPAN 05.212)

Senior Level Capstone (3 credits):

Advanced Spanish Grammar (WI) (SPAN 05.409)(prerequisite SPAN 05.212)

*For those students who begin the program with Spanish Reading and Conversation, 15 is the minimum number of credits that must be taken through Rowan University. For those students who begin the program with Spanish Reading and Composition, 12 is the minimum number of credits that must be taken through Rowan University.
