ABA INTERNSHIPS IN BANCROFT'S LINDENS PROGRAM

Bancroft's mission is to ensure that every person is given opportunities for lifelong learning and fulfillment. Our treatment philosophy is based on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis.

The Lindens program is uniquely designed to serve young people with both developmental disabilities and severe behavior problems. The Lindens specializes in treating children whose behaviors have progressed to the point that they cannot take part in normal activities – such as typical family life, school, and community recreational and socialization opportunities. We use applied behavior analysis assessment and treatment methods to identify the function of the problem behaviors and develop effective treatment plans.

Interns in The Lindens will have opportunities to:

- Participate in data collection for preference assessments, functional analyses, and treatment assessment.
- Enter and graph assessment data and 24 hour unit data.
- Participate in treatment planning discussions for individual cases.
- Attend team, IDT, and Grand Rounds meetings.
- Participate in reading groups and clinical seminars.
- Receive supervision hours towards BCaBA / BCBA certification
