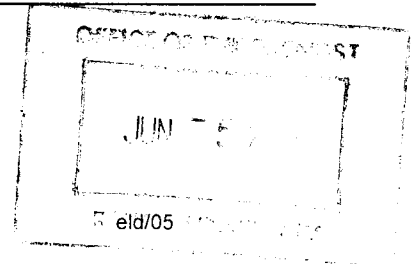

Details

Course title: Action Research in Education (0824.504) *EDST 24.504*

Sponsor: Thomas C. Monahan (for the Faculty of the Educational Leadership Department)

Rationale for the Minor Curriculum Change

Need: This minor curriculum revision seeks to remove the pre-requisite, *Foundations of Educational Policy* (0821.502). The original course proposal, which contained this pre-requisite, was submitted in error. A pre-requisite is not necessary for this introductory course.

Curricular Effect: The major curricular effect of this proposed change will be to offer more students opportunities to enroll in this course.

Changes: We propose only one change, as follows:

FROM: pre-requisite, *Foundations of Educational Policy* (0821.502).

TO: No pre-requisite

A new catalog description will reflect this change.
