2. A change in the credit hours from three (3) to four (4) is requested.
3. This course was erroneously entered as a three credit course with laboratory and although taught once within this time limitation, insufficient time is available for the laboratory portion of the course.  
  
A major portion of the laboratory time is expended in examining fossils to determine phylogentic differences upon which the taxonomic system is constructed. The many important groups which must be studied require additional time for discussion and study both in laboratory and in lecture.
4. The requested change will not affect the graduate program as this is not a required course. This course is primarily offered for teachers of Earth Science who perceive a need for a better understanding of Invertebrate Paleontology in order to present to their students the history of life on earth.
