

Square Deal to New Deal:  
Early 20th Century America

The new title for this course is the result of the splitting into two sections of a former upper level course entitled 20th Century U.S. History. In acknowledgement of the march of time, the old course was divided into two parts. The second part, already passed by the curriculum committee, is on the late 20th century. It retained the Hegis number of the old course.

This course will go through the World War II period. It is a theme course, and will feature those aspects of 20th century culture which the professor wants to emphasize in any given term.

Both of these courses are supplemented by an upper level course on World War II.

Prerequisites: U.S. History I Beginning to 1860.

Course Description:

This course will focus on a theme in the social history of early 20th century America. The Progressive Era, the New Era and the Great Depression will be touched upon in conjunction with themes which are common to all three periods.
