RE: Minor Curricular Changes: Title

1. Details:

- a. Change 1500-200 "Oriental Thought" to 1500-200 "Asian Thought"
- b. Sponsor: Department of Philosophy and Religion

2. Analysis:

- a. The change in nomenclature from "Oriental" to "Asian" is necessary to replace the Eurocentric sense of the term with the more descriptive geographically correct title.
- b. No change in curricular content is proposed, but this course will be a popular selection for students in the proposed major.

3. Consultation:

Conversations with Asian Studies groups at both here at Penn and at the University of Pennsylvania support our view that this is a very appropriate title change. Groups of student organizations have also adopted this change.
