Title: Athletic Training Program Credit Reduction

### Details

A. Change Requested:

To drop the requirement for students in the Athletic Training specialization to take the three credit course "Introduction to Health and Exercise Science" 0835.135

### Rationale

A. Statement of need:

Changes to the three credit Introduction to Health and Exercise Science course (adopted fall 2004) offered to all students from all three of the specializations within the Health and Exercise Science Department has made it unnecessary for students in the Athletic Training specialization to take this course. The content covered in the new course is unnecessary for Athletic Training specialization students. The content that was necessary in the old Introduction to Health and Exercise Science is now covered in the Introduction to Athletic Training course.

The faculty in the Athletic Training specialization, as well as the Faculty in the entire Health and Exercise Science Department recognize this over-site and have voted to drop this course from the required list of courses for this specialization.

B. Statement of curricular effect

Dropping the above mentioned course from the required bank of courses for the Athletic Training specialization will have a minor effect to the overall Health and Exercise Science Department. This change will reduce the demand for student seats in the Introduction to Health and Exercise Science course. The department views this as a favorable concept since we currently have been offering additional sections of the course and have hired adjuncts to teach these sections.

Programmatically, the reduction of three credits will more closely align the specialization with the university's target of offering undergraduate degrees in the area of 120 credits. This in turn, may attract more students to enroll in Rowan University and the Health and Exercise Science Department's Athletic Training Specialization.
