The Geography/Anthropology Department requests that the title of Comparative Ethnography (course number 2202.350) be changed to Comparative Cultures. The change of name would have no effect on the content of the course or on its place in the anthropology program.

We have found recently that the title Comparative Ethnography, while it makes reasonable sense to anthropologists, is often unintelligible or, worse, threatening to students. We feel that the new title requested will more clearly represent the content of the course (which is a survey of cultural types) to the student population, and thus produce higher enrollments.
