Course Proposal

1. Details

- a. Course Title: Courts and their Related Agencies
- b. Sponsors: Drs. Joe Davey, Allan Jiao, Cynthia Line
- c. Credit Hours: 3 s.h.
- d. Course Level: Graduate
- e. Curricular Effect: No effect on Undergraduate Curriculum. No effect on Graduate programs in other departments/colleges. Courses will be offered as ~~required~~ courses for graduate students in new Master's Degrees Program in Criminal Justice.
- f. Prerequisites: Admission to the program.
- g. Suggested time and scale of implementation: This is an elective that will be offered infrequently, dependent upon student interest.
- h. Staffing and resources: Current faculty and new faculty positions for the new Master's Degree Program in Criminal Justice.
- i. Library Impact: Current holdings will be sufficient.
- j. Short-term Evaluations: None
- k.

2. Rationale:

This course is an appropriate elective offering for the Master's in Criminal Justice. Advancement to policy-making positions in today's law enforcement and correctional agencies often require an in-depth understanding of the role and function of the courts, as well as the agencies that regularly interact with the courts. This elective will offer the student an opportunity to understand the function of agencies with which their career may bring them into regular contact.

The criminal justice system consists of the police, the courts and the correctional system. One of the more intractable problems within the system is the interaction between these three component parts, as well as many related agencies. Too often the personnel working in the criminal justice system are very familiar with the workings of their own agency but only vaguely aware of the work of their colleagues.

Plea-bargains account for as much as ninety percent of all criminal convictions. The nature of these “bargains” is often dependent upon the sentencing options available to the court. Public defenders, deputy District Attorneys and Judges regularly have to discuss the services of numerous related agencies that deal with problems confronting the defendant. This course will familiarize the student with the relationship between the courts and these agencies.

This course will concentrate on the Courts but examine the function of prosecutors offices, public defenders offices, probation departments, parole departments, drug and alcohol treatment programs, community correctional programs, work-release programs, half-way houses, educational and job training programs

3.Essence of Course

a. Objectives

- 1.To understand the criminal court system and its relationship to such related agencies as the District Attorney’s Office, the Public Defender’s Office, county jails, state prisons, alcohol and drug treatment programs, etc.
- 2.To examine some of the day to day problems facing these agencies currently as well as some of the suggested solutions from professionals in the field
- 3.To become familiar with the latest academic research on the functioning of these courts and agencies

c. Course Processes and Pedagogy

The course will meet for three hours per week for the semester. The processes and pedagogy will be largely determined by the faculty member offering the course.

d. Evaluation and Grading of Students: At the option of the faculty member who offers the course, students will be evaluated by term papers, written exams and class participation. At a minimum, students will be required to demonstrate:

1. An understanding of the role and function of criminal courts and the numerous agencies that relate to those courts.
2. The ability to find and review research articles
3. The ability to think critically about research and apply research to practical debates
4. Other activities may also be included per each professor.

e. Course Evaluation: The course will be evaluated using the Student Instructional Reports (SIRs) currently used by the department.

Catalog Description

This course will examine the administration of both trial courts and appellate courts on both the state and federal level. An emphasis will be placed on the nature of the relationship between the courts and agencies such as probation, parole, community corrections, work-release programs, drug and alcohol treatment and job training programs.
