

2. Rationale

- a. The Department of Art has proposed a minor change to the Core/Foundation program for all students entering one of the degree tracks offered by the department. As part of this minor change, the department concluded that the titles of the Core/Foundation classes should accurately reflect the course content taught in those classes. The department believes that a change of course title will enable prospective and currently enrolled students to know the subject matter to be taught in each of these required courses.
