0836.101 Motorcycle Education 2 S.H.

This course affords the opportunity for students to learn attitudes, skills and behaviors necessary to become a safe and proficient motorcycle operator. Riding practice follows lectures and audio-visual instruction. Students need a N.J. motorcycle permit or a current N.J. motorcycle license to complete the course. An opportunity to take the State License Qualification test is offered to all who successfully complete the course. Motorcycles are provided by local dealers. Students provide proper riding attire. Helmets and safety vests are provided. Participants with a valid N.J. motorcycle license and who pass a pre-course knowledge and skill test can assume a leadership role and take part in the instructor preparation. Methods and techniques of administering and teaching safety programs are studied.
