(Minor Curriculum Change)

Title: Proposal To Change Specialization in Finance

Sponsors: Dr. Robert E. Pritchard, Chair, Accounting and Finance representing the Accounting/Finance faculty

Scope: Increase the Finance Specialization by 3 sh from 27 sh to 30 sh, and require the course "Statistics II."

Relation To Curriculum: This will affect only those students specializing in Finance.

Prerequisites As determined by course requirements

Suggested Time: Implement Fall 1986

Resource Requirements: Department of Mathematics and Computer Science--See letter from Dr. Fran Maset.

Rationale: The Business Administration core is being modified consistant with the consultants recommendations for AACSB accreditation. The two existing law courses, Principles of Law I and II are being phased out. One new law course will be required of all Business Administration majors and included in the core. This will have the effect of reducing the core by three semester hours. The consultants recommended adding a second course in statistics. After review by the faculty, the faculty recommended adding Statistics II to the more quantitative specializations as needed. The Accounting/Finance faculty feel that students specializing the finance would benefit from Statistics II.

Essence of Specialization: The specialization in fiance is designed to prepare GSC students for careers in corporate finance, banking, brokerage and the like, all of which are becoming increasingly quantitative. The only change proposed is the addition of "Statistics II."

Results of Consultation: All members of the Accounting faculty support this proposal. The proposal is consistant with recommendations of our consultants. See also letter from Dr. Fran Masat.
