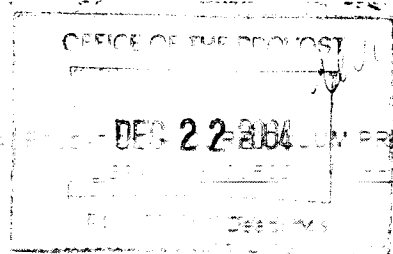

**PROPOSAL: Elimination of FINANCIAL INTERMEDIARIES (0504-432) &
FINANCIAL MARKETS (0504-420)**

September 2004

1. Details

a. Change Requested:

Eliminate Financial Intermediaries (0504-432) and Financial Markets (0504-420) as required courses in the undergraduate finance specialization and eliminate them from course offerings.

b. Sponsor:

Ihsan Isik, Ph.D.
Department of Accounting and Finance

c. Implementation:

Starting Fall Semester, 2005

d. Curricular Effect:

“Financial Intermediaries” and “Financial Markets” are required major courses for the finance specialization. They are replaced by a broader new course “Financial Institutions and Markets” (a new course proposal SCC#04-05-102 being submitted simultaneously). Financial Intermediaries course and its HEGIS number (0504-432) and Financial Markets course and its HEGIS number (0504-420) will be eliminated from the undergraduate catalog and system.

2. Rationale

The subjects covered in Financial Markets and Financial Intermediaries courses will be discussed in more integrated manner within the new proposed course “Financial Institutions and Markets”. Also, this will give some room to finance majors to take one more finance elective in order to further broaden their understanding of a sub-field in finance. The content of the new proposed course is sufficient to meet the Finance Program learning goal: “*students will have a broad understanding of financial theory and institutions*”. Besides, in many schools and textbooks, both subjects are presented together. Please refer to the new course proposal of Financial Institutions and Markets (SCC#04-05-102) for further information.
