Rationale for Request

This request is based on the Department of Economics response to the Strategic Planning Committee's recommendation that the economics major program be phased out. In response to these recommendations the Department of Economics met with Dr. James to acquire his support for the retention of the economics major program. Dr. James agreed to recommend that the economics major program be retained. He strongly recommended that several of the upper division courses be opened-up to attract a greater student enrollment from non majors. The Department agreed to drop one prerequisite for this course. Economics majors will still be required to take the current prerequisites of Macroeconomics and Microeconomics.
