I have received from Dr. O'Day notification that the Graduate Program in Junior College Teaching Specialization: English has been approved. While I am happy that you and the English Department have given attention to the program, I do not believe approval as a new program is needed. Therefore, this letter is to acknowledge receipt of the outline made for the program and to urge that you and the English Department proceed with making the provisions available to students.

It would be good if you developed similar guidance materials for students in other academic specializations.

The only concern I have is the dropping of the psychological requirement. Is there not a great deal of concern about junior college faculty being unable to relate effectively with students?
