

I. Title: Guitar Class II  
Sponsor: Music Department  
Thomas Wade

II. Essence: It is an undergraduate course of one semester credit with Guitar Class I as a prerequisite. Implementation would be in Spring of 1980.

III. Details: A. Present faculty and facilities are adequate.  
B. There is no overlapping with any other course in the catalogue. Guitar Class II uniquely provides skills for playing the guitar.  
C. Please note items "A" and "B" under topical outline (IV). Students will have acquired skills enabling them to play for their own enjoyment or as a resource for use as an elementary school teacher.  
D. Students will receive a letter grade for the course.

IV. Topical Outline: A. Harmonic Theory  
a. primary chords in all keys.  
b. secondary chords in all keys.  
c. 7th, 9th, 11th chords.  
B. Melody Reading  
a. rhythm skills  
b. note recognition  
c. playing in many positions  
d. scales  
C. Playing Tunes for Enjoyment!  
D. Texts

V. Rationale: An additional semester of study in addition to the presently offered Guitar Class is needed to allow students to acquire substantive skills on the instrument. As with all musical instruments, so too with the guitar are subtle physical reflexes needed. Presently, Guitar Class is offered each semester with many people repeating the course. The teacher copes with beginners and students with one semester's training simultaneously. A second semester of the course would simplify the curriculum.
