MINOR CURRICULAR CHANGE

I. Rationale

The Health and Physical Education Department wants to establish a policy in which no student would graduate with a degree in Health and Physical Education without having completed a specialization. Presently we have three approved specializations in addition to the teacher certification program. This request is to have teacher certification designated as a specialization. We recommend our specializations be listed as they appear on next page.

This would clarify the way our programs are presented. Every Health and Physical Education major would take between 51 and 61 hours of general education. They would also take the following core courses, regardless of specialization, as they are basic to any degree in Health and Physical Education:
