1) Corrections and Changes to Course Prerequisites

The History Department proposes the following changes to course prerequisites, to begin as soon as possible. These changes correct errors and bring the prerequisite requirements into line with our current program. In particular, since Western Civilization II (2205.101) is no longer a required course in the History Department, several course prerequisites need to be changed to allow the option of World History Since 1500 (2205.120) instead. The history major curriculum was revised a few years ago, and these prerequisite problems have become evident as the registrar has begun enforcing prerequisites.
