

RE: Request for Program Title Change

1. Details

- a. Change Requested: It is requested that the title of the M.A. Program in Junior College Teaching be changed to M.A. Program in Community College Education.
- b. Sponsor: Dr. Richard R. Smith, Program Coordinator

2. Rationale

The M.A. Program in Junior College Teaching has been preparing students to teach and assume leadership roles in community colleges for more than 15 years. This program has graduated students who have become professors, deans and chairpersons in post-secondary schools within many states. The literature typically refers to the term Community College when considering the public sector and when referring to this specialization as an area of educational study. Except for a few states, the term "Junior College" refers to associate degree granting institutions within the private sector. For the most part, junior college programs and degree options are more limited than those of a community college. The requested change is more reflective of our scope of offerings, the terminology within the national literature, and the nature of the colleges we serve.
