

1. DETAILS

- a. Add the following graduate courses as prerequisites for
0504.500 Managerial Finance: 0502.500 Managerial Accounting
and 0507.500 Quantitative Methods
- b. Sponsor: School of Business Administration, Drs. Robert E.
Pritchard and Gulser Meric
- c. Implementation: starting fall semester 1990

2. RATIONALE

At the present time, Managerial Finance does not have any prerequisites. The instructor notes that, at present, there are very significant differences in the students' knowledge of quantitative methods and accounting. Some students took Accounting I (the existing prerequisite in accounting) several years ago and have forgotten the material. Even if their knowledge is current, Accounting I does not provide sufficient background for Managerial Finance. Also, students need Quantitative Methods to understand Managerial Finance.

Dr. Meric and Pritchard believe that the addition of the two prerequisites will assure that all students have the required background to satisfactorily complete the course.

3. RESULTS OF CONSULTATION

Drs. Pritchard and Meric have discussed the problem of lack of adequate student preparation for Managerial Finance and concur that adding Quantitative Methods and Managerial Accounting as prerequisites is most important.
