CHANGE IN COURSE TITLE AND CATALOG DESCRIPTION FOR 1701.120

1. Existing Title and Catalog Description:

1701.120

Introductory Mathematics I

A basic course in mathematics which includes a study of elementary algebra through equations of one and two variables. This course is appropriate for those students whose mathematical background is not sufficiently strong for them to enter Introductory Mathematics II.

2. Proposed Title and Catalog Description:

1701.120

Introductory Algebra

A basic course in mathematics which includes a study of introductory algebra through equations of one and two variables. This course is appropriate for those students whose mathematical background is not sufficiently strong for them to enter Intermediate Algebra.

3. Rationale:

The department of Mathematics and Computer Science feels that the existing title is confusing and unclear; the proposed title is more specific and accurate. The change in catalog description is included so as to agree with the proposed title change for Introductory Mathematics II.

4. Curricular Impact:

The proposed changes are not expected to affect the curriculum. They will, however, make college transcripts and the college catalog more easily understood.
