CHANGE IN COURSE TITLE AND CATALOG DESCRIPTION FOR 1701.121

1. Existing Title and Catalog Description:

1701.121

Introductory Mathematics II, Social Science

This track emphasizes the mathematical skills, and techniques used in business and social sciences. Topics included are: review of algebra, linear functions, determinants, progressions, combinations, and permutations.

2. Proposed Title and Catalog Description:

1701.121

Intermediate Algebra

This course emphasizes the mathematical skills, and techniques used in business and social sciences. Topics included are: review of algebra, linear and quadratic functions and graphs, determinants, progressions, combinations, and permutations.

3. Rationale:

The department of Mathematics and Computer Science feels that the existing title is confusing and unclear; the proposed title is more specific and accurate. The change in catalog description is included to reflect the fact that there are no longer three tracks in this course, and to clarify the existing course content.

4. Curricular Impact:

The proposed changes are not expected to affect the curriculum. They will, however, make college transcripts and the college catalog more easily understood.
