

MINOR CURRICULAR CHANGE

1. Details:

A. Request change of course title from "Middle East Since 1453" to "Modern Middle East".

B. Dr. Corinne Blake and the history department

2. Rationale:

A. Dr. Blake plans to offer two lower level survey courses in Middle Eastern history. The first half of this course, "Islamic Civilization", which examines Islamic history from the 7th century A.D. to the 18th century, will be offered every fall. "Modern Middle East" will focus on the Middle East in the 19th and 20th centuries.

B. Curricular Effect:

There will be no effect on the curriculum, this course will still be offered as a major elective that fulfills the non-western/global track electives.

CATALOG DESCRIPTION

Modern Middle East

This course provides an introduction to the history of the Middle East from 1800 to the present, a period of intense change in the region. It examines the transition from empires to nation states and the rise and fall of European imperialism in the area. This course is typically offered in the spring semester.
