Students provide proper riding ~~gear~~ <sup>ATTIRE</sup>. Helmets and safety vests are provided. Participants with a valid N.J. motorcycle license and who pass a pre-course knowledge and skill test can assume a leadership role and take part in instructor preparation. Methods and techniques of administering and teaching safety programs are studied.

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
