RESOLUTION # 6

APPROVAL OF CONSOLIDATION OF DEGREE PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the Department of Music currently offers three Bachelor of Music degree programs in Performance, Jazz Studies, and Composition, and

WHEREAS, the consolidation of these programs is consistent with the guidelines of the National Association of Schools of Music, and

WHEREAS, the consolidation of these three programs will enhance administrative efficiency and academic focus, and

WHEREAS, this consolidation has been approved by the College of Fine & Performing Arts, the University Senate, Provost, and Academic Affairs Committee of the Board of Trustees

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rowan University Board of Trustees approves the consolidation of the Bachelor of Music in Performance, the Bachelor of Music in Jazz Studies, and the Bachelor of Music in Composition into one degree program, Bachelor of Music, with specializations in performance, jazz studies, composition, and music education.
