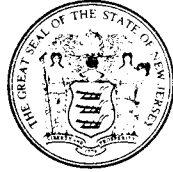

1. Change requested: Add Math for Management I. ²⁰² (1703-~~301~~) as a prerequisite for Principles of Finance (0504.300).
2. Rationale: We have found that students need a firm knowledge of math at the level indicated to properly handle Finance. Through the structure of our program and advisement, our four-year students usually have this Math before taking Finance. However, we have found some problems with transfer students who do not normally have this level of math. The change requested is designed to deal with this situation by making the prerequisite specific.
3. Impact: There is no specific impact on curriculum design. In advising transfer students we make clear the need to take Math for Management Science I promptly here at Glassboro.
4. Consultation: The Math Department has no objection.
