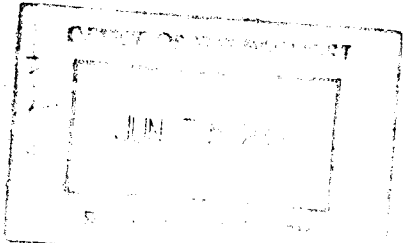

Course Title Change

Details:

Change Requested (From and To):

- a. I am requesting a change from the old title, "Readings in World Literature," to a new title, "Readings in Non-Western Literature."
- b. Sponsor: Cathy Parrish

Rationale:

- a. Need for change: "Readings in World Literature" is our most popular general education course. It has the "lit" and the M/G designation. It is also required of all our secondary-education English majors because the state mandates their exposure to non-western literature. However, many transfer students have taken a 100-level lit course called "World Literature" at their community college. Since the community college "World Literature" focuses on the masterpieces of Western civilization, it transfers into our system not as "World Literature" but as "Masterpieces of Western Literature," which is unnecessarily confusing. Our "Readings in World Literature," on the other hand, is required of secondary education majors because it focuses **exclusively** on **non**-Western literature. We would like to make our course title more accurate and precise to avoid confusion.
- b. This new title will have no effect on department curricular design.

Results of Consultation:

- a. The change in title has no effect on this class, other courses, programs, or majors. Thus, I did not consult with the heads of any other programs.

Since there are no changes in the way we will teach the course, present library resources are more than adequate; therefore I did not seek a library consultation.
