Content change to delete the structure of Music Learning Theory and the comparison of the New Jersey Core Curriculum Standards with the National Standards in Music.

Rationale

a. Statement of need for change:

All education programs began the revision process during the 2003-2004 academic year to align our professional course work with the New Jersey Administrative Code introduced in January 2004. The creation of a new course for the department of music, Teaching in Music Learning Communities II (TLC-M) will introduce and develop the following topics: 1) the structure of Music Learning and 2) the comparison of New Jersey Core Curriculum standards with the role of curriculum in schools. Therefore, in this course, Teaching and Learning Music A: Elementary General Music, students will only apply through examination of materials and techniques those two aforementioned concepts to the elementary general music classroom. Furthermore, the addition of the TLC-M course will nullify the need for sequence in the junior level specialty courses (Elementary General Music Methods, Vocal Methods and Techniques or Instrumental Methods and Techniques) hence invalidating the designation of sequence in the title.

b. Statement of Curricular Effect:

Students will have more opportunity to apply and practice appropriate elementary methods now that a topic that took considerable time will be introduced and developed in the new course TLC II-M.

c. Changes in Requirements:
