

MINOR CURRICULAR CHANGE PROPOSAL
Vocal Methods and Techniques
Instrumental Methods and Techniques

1. Details:

- a. We would like to request that the courses entitled, Vocal Methods and Techniques, 0832.330, and Instrumental Methods and Techniques, 0832.331, be changed from three credits to two credits each. Furthermore, we would like to change the name of the courses to Pedagogy III B: Vocal Methods & Techniques, and Pedagogy III B: Instrumental Methods & Techniques

2. Rationale:

- a. Vocal Methods and Techniques is the second required methods course for Music Education undergraduates who are in the vocal track. Instrumental Methods and Techniques is the second required methods course for Music Education undergraduates who are in the instrumental track. Those courses follow the General Music Methods course. The two-course sequence (General Music Methods/Vocal methods and Techniques, or General Music Methods/Instrumental Methods and Techniques) constitute the complete methods component for the music education program. Because the two-course sequence comprises six credits, the Music Education program is one credit beyond the allotted 30 credit teacher training component. Therefore, we are not in compliance with the Standards for State Approval of Teacher Education.
