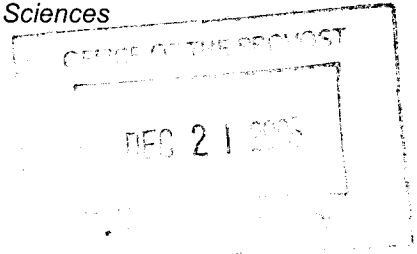

One change proposed: Course description

Details

a. Change Requested (From and To)

The description of the course should change from the current version to the proposed version as follows:

Previous version:

Writing the Novel teaches students the structure, technique, and apparatus of the novel, and provides feedback and guidance through extensive instructor critique and workshop-style evaluation of students' work in class. Students prepare a synopsis of a novel and four sample chapters, as well as an analysis of a favored author's work and a presentation to a mock editorial board that will make a decision about whether to publish the student's proposed work. Students also develop a clear understanding of the business end of writing and publishing book-length fiction

Current version:

Writing the Novel teaches students the structure, technique, and apparatus of the literary novel, and provides feedback and guidance through extensive instructor critique and workshop-style evaluation. It is recommended that students enrolling in this course have some prior practice in literary novel-writing or at least a strong background in reading the literary novel. Students are required to submit four consecutive novel chapters with synopsis by the end of the course.
