All students must take 42 credits of General Education and Rowan Experience courses. Students must also take the following: One Rowan Seminar (excluding transfers), one Multicultural/Global Studies (M/G), one Writing Intensive (WI), one Broad-based Literature, one Artistic and Creative Experience (ACE), and one Public Speaking course. **M/G, LIT, ACE, WI and RS courses that are taken within the major program of study DO NOT COUNT towards this minimum total of 42 credits. Sociology majors are required to take 30 credits in upper level courses: 18 must be in Sociology.** Courses may be transferred from Community Colleges up to a maximum of 67 hours; all such transfers are counted as lower-level courses. Students must have a 2.0 overall GPA as well as a 2.0 GPA in sociology courses taken at Rowan.

Sociology Major Requirements

33 Credits in Sociology:

- 2.0 overall average
- 2.0 average in sociology
- 15 credits at Rowan University
- 18 credits at 300, 400, 500 level
- Letter grades only
- C- minimum grade in all sociology courses
- No more than two courses can be repeated and each of these two can be repeated no more than once
- Required courses
 - Intro
 - Classical Theory – preferred by junior year
 - Sociological Methods – preferred by junior year
 - Social Statistics – preferred by junior year
 - Senior Seminar

Overall Credits:

- 120 total credits**
- 30 credits overall at 300, 400, 500 level
- Up to 10% may be P/NC
- Maximum Community College transfer credits = 67 credits
- Community College credits transfer in as lower-level (100, 200)
- D grades are not accepted. This rule applies to sociology and non-sociology courses**
