Speaker: Dr. Sergei Khrushchev, Senior Fellow at the Watson Institute for International Studies, Brown University.

Dr. Khrushchev is an expert in the history of the Cold War, turning points in U.S. and Soviet relations, and Soviet missiles and space development, in which he played an active role, from 1958-1968. He is the son of the late Nikita Khrushchev, former general secretary of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union.
