## **Join Rowan in marking Hollybush Summit's 40th anniversary**

Date: Sunday, June 24 noon – 4:00 pm

Share some Rowan history and join the University community in marking the 40th anniversary of the Hollybush Summit at an open house on Sunday, June 24, from noon until 4 p.m., at Hollybush, Whitney Avenue.

On June 23 and 25, 1967, with the world watching, U.S. President Lyndon B. Johnson and Soviet Premier Alexei Kosygin met face to face at Hollybush Mansion to discuss the Arab-Israeli Six-Day War, which found them on opposing sides, and other world issues. While Johnson and Kosygin did not sign a formal agreement, they did acknowledge that the Hollybush Summit was successful, and the summit helped start to ease some Cold War tensions.

The June 24 open house will mark the start of a yearlong celebration and will feature tours of the recently renovated mansion; a chance to meet faculty, alumni and townspeople who watched the events unfold; and an opportunity to videotape memories of the summit and become a part of Hollybush history.

Rowan also will hold more activities throughout the year that focus on issues that faced the world then and face it now, including a symposium on nuclear nonproliferation in mid-spring 2008 and lectures and special activities sponsored by several University departments.
