## c o u r t Showcase at Rowan

Rowan University's Lab Theatre and Dance Extensions presents Paule Turner's **c o u r t** with their piece, *Parasites of Heaven*. As choreographer and Assistant Professor of Dance at Rowan, Turner performs with a cast of seven, consisting of Rowan alumni and faculty. *Parasites of Heaven* was first conceived and premiered last November as part of the Department of Theater and Dance's Incubator Project which challenged Rowan artists to create a piece inspired by the novel *Beautiful Losers* by Leonard Cohen. This display of theatre art explores elements of physical motion and the spoken word by "blurring sexuality with faith in an erotic chamber dance," says Turner. "It aims to be rough and beautiful at the same time."

*Parasites of Heaven* will be performed in Lab's black box **Thursday through Saturday, September 21-23 and 28-30 at 8PM and Sunday, September 24 and October 1 at 3PM**. Tickets can be purchased at the box office outside the Lab Theatre Rm. 159 in Bunce Hall. The cost is \$10 for general admission and \$5 for students, faculty and seniors.
