## Comedy Challenge

### **"Catch A Rising Star College Comedy Challenge"**

Rowan to host competition Nov. 6

Catch A Rising Star Comedy Clubs has announced that it will hold its second annual "Catch A Rising Star College Comedy Challenge." The competition will feature aspiring comedians from select New Jersey colleges and universities, including The College of New Jersey (TCNJ), Rowan University, Stockton College, and Centenary College.

The student-comedians will compete against each other at their respective schools in early November, with guest judges scoring their performances. Three finalists at each school will then move on to the final competition at Catch A Rising Star in Atlantic City. The ultimate winner will get a paid gig at a future Catch show.

#### **The competition will be held at Rowan on Monday Nov. 6.**

Catch A Rising Star held its first College Comedy Challenge in 2005, with over 30 student-comedians taking part in the competition. Princeton University's Patrick Cunningham was the eventual winner and later appeared at Catch A Rising Star in Princeton. A west coast version was held at University of Nevada-Reno.

Catch A Rising Star has a well-known reputation for discovering new comedic talent. The club that helped launch the careers of standouts comics like: Robin Williams, Billy Crystal, Rosie O'Donnell, Jerry Seinfeld, Ray Romano, Chris Rock, Bob Saget and Robert Wuhl, seeks to "catch" the best talent that colleges have to offer, with the help of T-Mobile. Several Catch A Rising Star related TV specials have been aired by HBO, CBS and other networks.

"We want to discover the next Seinfeld," said Craig Neier, CEO of Catch A Rising Star. "We're looking for that young person who will take the comedy world by storm. Every college has their comedians. This is the chance for them to step forward and show us what they have."

New Jersey native Rodney Laney, who performs professionally throughout the country, will be the host of each of the competitions.
