

THE FREIBERGER SCHOLARSHIP FOR FOREIGN LANGUAGE STUDENTS

Objective: In accord with the wide-ranging interests and pursuits of the late Dr. Erika Freiburger, the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures has instituted the **Erika Freiburger Memorial Scholarship**. This scholarship is intended to encourage qualified foreign language students in to take advantage of the opportunities available for foreign study. Its purpose is to serve students in their desire to improve their language skills and increase their knowledge and awareness of the culture they are studying.

Eligibility:

1. This scholarship is intended to offset travel costs for Rowan students going abroad to study in credit-related programs or to participate in variable credit work-related field service.
2. It is intended for full-time foreign language students currently enrolled in major or minor programs.
3. The student's GPA in the major and in the language program must be at least 3.0.
4. A student must have completed, or have language experience equivalent to, 4 semesters in the language of the country in which the stay will occur.

Fill out the information requested below and submit to the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures. The deadline is April 15 and the scholarship will be awarded in early May. It is awarded to those students who are studying/have studied abroad during the academic year about to conclude, or during the summer thereafter.
