Spring 2008 Enrollment Data

This Research Brief contains a snapshot of Spring 2008 enrollment and student credit hours as of the 10th day of class. This page summarizes enrollment by FTE, gender, ethnic category, and courseload.

Full-Time Equivalent Student (FTE)

There are two common formulae used in the calculation of an FTE.

Definition 1: The sum of all undergraduate students' semester credit hours divided by 15 plus the sum of all graduate students' semester credit hours divided by 12.

Undergraduate (NU, NO, FR, SO, JR, SR, PB, CR)

SCH = 115,721

$$115,721 / 15 = 7,714.73 \text{ FTE}$$

Graduate (NG, GO, CG, GR, DR) SCH = 6,739

$$6,739 / 12 = 561.58 \text{ FTE}$$

Total FTE = 7,714.73 + 561.58 = 8,276.31

Definition 2: The total full-time headcount plus 1/3 of the part-time headcount.

Full-time Headcount = 7,556

Part-time Headcount = 2,284 / 3 = 761.33

Total FTE = 7,556 + 761.33 = 8,317.33

**SCHs by Course College, Course Department and Course Level
Spring 2008**

This display focuses on the semester credit hours (SCHs) generated by a course (in a department, in a college).

For example, if a doctoral student (major = D928, home department of Educational Leadership, home college of Education) enrolls in a three-credit 100-level Psychology class, the SCHs associated with her (the doctoral student's) registration in the Psychology class are recorded at the lower division undergraduate level (to reflect the classification of the 100-level class) in the department of Psychology in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences. This means that her contribution to the FTE calculation is determined using a divisor of 15 (to reflect the level of the class).

For example, if a doctoral student (major = D928, home department of Educational Leadership, home college of Education) enrolls in a three-credit 100-level Psychology class, the SCHs associated with her (the doctoral student's) registration in the Psychology class are recorded at the graduate level (to reflect her doctoral status) in the department of Psychology in the College of Liberal Arts & Sciences (the department and college which house the Psychology class). This means that her contribution to the FTE calculation is determined using a divisor of 12 (to reflect her doctoral status).
