

Important Notice About CPCE Health Requirements

The State of New Jersey has health immunization requirements that include all matriculated CPCE students. Rowan University must abide by these regulations, and so it is important that all students please read the information below and be sure to comply.

Effective July 15th, all new and continuing matriculated Rowan CPCE students (with the exception of those enrolled in a degree program offered fully online) will be required to comply with Student Health requirements regardless of their campus location. This requirement is for both current and new students.

Please complete all the required health forms and return them before July 15th to:

All information must be complete as follows:

- Immunization form
 - 2 measles, mumps and rubella (MMR)
 - Meningitis (Menactra™) if living on campus
 - Hepatitis B series X 3 vaccines (only for students taking ≥ 12 credits)
- Tuberculosis screening form and/or PPD (mantoux test)
 - *A Chest Xray radiologist report is required if PPD (mantoux) test is ≥ 10 mm.*
- Personal form
- Meningitis response form
- All fulltime students are required to have health insurance. Please review student health insurance requirements at www.rowan.edu/health.
