

SERVICES OFFERED TO STUDENTS AT ROWAN UNIVERSITY STUDENT HEALTH CENTER www.rowan.edu/health

The Rowan University Health Center offers most services at no charge as we are supported, in part, by student fees. Evaluation by a physician or nurse practitioner, some medication and treatment, and/or referral of illnesses or injuries are offered to all University students. Intercollegiate sports physicals are available to all students after their primary physician completes their initial physical form. Students receiving regular allergy injections may have them given by a Registered Nurse if certain conditions are met. For questions or appointments, call the Student Health Center at (856) 256-4333.

We offer certain lab testing and immunizations at low cost here. For these services, you will receive a receipt which can be submitted for reimbursement from your health insurance company. We also offer clearance physical examinations, PPD Tuberculosis (Mantoux) testing, and allergy injections for a charge.

If a medication or treatment is required that is not in our formulary, you will be required to purchase them on your own according to your health insurance. You are also responsible for laboratory, radiology or specialty referrals and treatments.

If a student requires additional services, local physicians, dentists and other providers are available off-campus. Check with your insurance provider FIRST to find a physician who is a preferred provider. Although not needed for an appointment at the Student Health Center, bringing your insurance card with you will help us refer you to a participating specialist or facility when necessary.

We also provide information and educational brochures pertaining to health promotion, a variety of illnesses, or injury. We sponsor monthly health promotion initiatives throughout the year. You may also receive personal counseling, including individual, group and couples counseling or psychotherapy at no charge through Counseling and Psychological Services at (856) 256-4222.

FAMCARE, INC. SERVICES

Reproductive health care services are provided to both male and female students at the Health Center by a private non-profit local agency called FamCare, Inc. The following services are offered at a reasonable charge:

Female ("Well Woman") Exams - Pap smear/pelvic exam, Breast Exam, Anemia Screen, Testing for Sexually Transmitted Infections, Health Counseling, Birth Control Medications, Free HIV testing at Glassboro Site, HPV vaccine (Gardasil®)

Contraceptive Birth Control (low cost) - Oral Contraception (pills), Ortho Evra® Patch, Nuva Ring®, Depoprovera Injections, IUD, Implanon®

Male Exams - Testing for Sexually transmitted Infections (Herpes, Chlamydia, Gonorrhea), Cancer Screening. Free HIV testing available at Glassboro Site

FamCare provides on-site care each Wednesday night at the Student Health Center. FamCare services are also available at the Glassboro office on Main Street. Call 1-888-794-1235 or 856-881-7495 for information or to schedule an appointment. They provide an important service for a reasonable charge. Students are responsible for payment of these charges at time of service.
