Submitting Your Application

Completed applications should be returned to the Admissions Office with a \$65 non-refundable application fee. Check or money order payable to Rowan University. Major credit card/check card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express) accepted. Applicants must also submit with the application all supporting documentation (transcripts, test scores, recommendations). Applications may also be securely submitted electronically. Apply online at <http://www.rowan.edu/applications>. Online applications require use of a credit card to pay the \$65 application fee. You may submit one application per semester.

Academic Records

Freshman Applicants

Students who have not yet graduated high school are considered Freshman Applicants regardless of how many college credits may have been earned. If you have graduated high school and are currently in your first semester of college, you are still considered a freshman and must file the Freshman Application. The required documentation for freshman applicants include:

- Completed application
- \$65 application fee
- Official high school transcript
- SAT and/or ACT scores
- Completed portfolio review, audition or departmental interview for Fine & Performing Arts applicants
- Official transcript from each institution where college credits may have been earned.

Including letters of recommendation from teachers/counselors and first-semester senior year grades can strengthen an application. If you have attended any college or post-high school institution, or have been enrolled in any college courses or dual credit courses, you must supply Rowan University with an official transcript from the institution where those courses were taken or where the credit has been earned.

Before completing your application

You will need the following items:

- A copy of your best SAT and/or ACT scores
- A copy of your high school transcript(s)
- Copies of transcripts for any completed college courses
- A list of courses in progress for the current academic year
- A valid VISA, MasterCard, Discover or American Express credit/debit card if you would like to pay the application fee via credit card (credit/debit card payment required to submit online).

Transfer Applicants

A student who has attended a college or university following graduation from high school and has completed a minimum of 12 transferable college credits by the application deadline is considered a transfer applicant. Transfer applicants must submit an official transcript from each institution attended. Applicants with fewer than 24 credits completed at the time of application must also submit official high school transcripts and SAT or ACT scores. Transfer students applying with 45 or more credits completed must choose a major (cannot choose Exploratory Studies).

The required documentation for transfer applicants include:

- Transfer applicants having earned fewer than 24 college credits at the time of application must also submit an official high school transcript

- Completed portfolio review, audition or departmental interview for Fine & Performing Arts applicants.
- Transfers may attach a list of work or life experiences relevant to their studies (optional).

Scholarship Opportunities

The University offers a range of merit-based scholarship awards. No special application is required to be evaluated for merit-based awards. All students offered admission as freshmen are considered for first-time freshman scholarships. All New Jersey community college graduates offered admission are considered for the competitive transfer scholarships. The Scholarship Committee selects award recipients based on their academic record.

Financial Aid

Applicants wishing to be considered for need-based financial aid must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 15. This form may be obtained from your high school guidance office, Rowan's financial aid office (856-256-4250) or your local public library. The FAFSA may also be completed and filed electronically via the Internet at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Rowan University's federal school code is 002609.

Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program

New Jersey residents only. EOF is a special admissions program for students who meet certain financial and academic requirements. Applicants to the EOF program must be seeking full-time admission, have been residents of New Jersey for at least 12 months prior to entering Rowan University, come from an educationally and economically disadvantaged background, and ineligible for admission by traditional standards. Students receive extensive counseling, tutorial services and other support services to ensure success at Rowan. A residential five-week pre-college summer program is required of students who are admitted through the EOF program.
