Application Instructions for Re-Entrance / Re-Admission

Please read all instructions carefully before completing application.

- ▶ To apply for re-entrance/re-admission, complete and return the application form and submit all required documents to the Rowan University Office of Admissions by the deadlines below.

- ▶ If you have completed course work at another college since withdrawing from Rowan University, you must provide official transcripts for the credits attempted and earned.
- ▶ If you were initially admitted through the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program and wish to once again receive EOF financial aid, mark the appropriate box on the application and inform the EOF Director in writing of your interest in returning to the program and the University.

Re-Entrance (withdrew in good academic standing)

- ▶ Must have been previously admitted and matriculated at Rowan University (formerly Rowan College of New Jersey and Glassboro State College).
- ▶ Must have voluntarily withdrew from Rowan University.
- ▶ Must have had a satisfactory grade point average at the time of withdraw from Rowan University.
- ▶ Re-Entrance students have no financial obligation to Rowan University.
- ▶ If you are re-entering any Education major, Business major or Engineering major, you must receive written approval from the chairperson of that department in order to re-enter. The Admissions staff will request this departmental approval on your behalf as part of the re-entrant application evaluation process.

Re-Admission (academically dismissed)

- ▶ You must be absent from the University one full calendar year from the official start date of your dismissal
- ▶ You must submit a statement about the activities in which you were involved since dismissal (e.g.: employment, Military, academic work, etc).
- ▶ You must submit three letters of recommendation from faculty, counselors or employers. Direct letters to: "Admissions Committee." Send to the attention of: "Re-Admission Secretary."
- ▶ You must contact the Re-Admission secretary to schedule a personal interview with an Admissions Counselor.
- ▶ Upon request, you must be tested by the Academic Success Center.
- ▶ If applicable, you may submit certification from a physician that a health problem may have contributed to academic difficulties, and/or certification from a psychologist or psychiatrist that an emotional problem contributed to academic difficulties.
