Subj: Changes to the BSBA Curriculum -- Prerequisites

As part of the work to update the college catalog our department reviewed the curriculum and would like to make several small changes relating specifically to prerequisites. These changes do not affect any other departments and all of the changes have been reviewed by the co-chairpersons and were approved by the faculty at its regular meeting on March 3, 1982.

1. Add prerequisites to 0504.300 Principles of Finance. Add the following prerequisites: 2204.101 and 2204.102 "Macro" and "Microeconomics," 1703.202 "Math For Management" and 1703.261 "Statistics for Management," in addition to the existing prerequisite 0502.211 "Accounting II."  
Rationale: These courses are all required courses and are designed for the first two years of study. Most students have completed them prior to taking Principles of Finance. Explicitly stating them as prerequisites will avoid confusion and help to eliminate the problem of students taking courses out of sequence.
2. Change prerequisite for 0504.324 "Capital Budgeting and Financial Planning" from 0504.320 "Managerial Finance" to 0504.300 "Principles of Finance."  
Rationale: The latter provides sufficient background and will facilitate scheduling.

3. Change the prerequisite for 0504.325 "Long-Term Asset Management" from 0504.320 "Managerial Finance" to 0504.300, "Principles of Finance."  
Rationale: Managerial Finance I and II (renamed "Managerial Finance" and "Long-Term Asset Management" respectively) are not sequential and may be taken in either order. Principles of Finance is the correct prerequisite.
4. Change the prerequisite for 0506.303 "Management of Multinational Business" to 0506.300 "Organizational Behavior," (formerly named Process of Management), 0504.300 "Principles of Finance" and 0509.300 "Principles of Marketing." Rationale: A strong knowledge base in each of these fields is required for an understanding of international business.
5. Change the prerequisite for 0506.304 "Organization Change and Development" from 0506.101 "Intro to Management" to 0506.300 "Organizational Behavior."  
Rationale: Knowledge of materials in Organizational Behavior are required for this course.
6. Change prerequisite for 0506.402 "Business Management Simulation." Delete 0506.101 "Intro to Management" and replace with 0506.300 "Organizational Behavior." Rationale: Knowledge of materials in Organizational Behavior is required for this course.
7. Change prerequisite for 0506.375 "Retail Sales Promotion" from 0509.300 "Principles of Marketing" to 0509.372 "Retailing." Knowledge of retailing is required and "Retailing" has "Principles of Marketing" as a prerequisite.
