RE: Change in Credits, Cell Biology

→ It is hereby requested that Cell Biology be changed from a 3-credit course to a 4-credit course. At the present, this course is scheduled with a single lecture period and a laboratory period weekly. By changing it to a 4-credit course, two lecture periods would then be held weekly. This extra lecture period is necessary to provide additional time for discussion, for treating certain topics (e.g., membranes) in greater detail, and for adding new topics. Those topics that would be added deal primarily with nuclear phenomena, including:

- I. Microtubules
- II. Chromosomal structure and variation
- III. Mechanics of mitosis and meiosis
- IV. Cytogenetics

The proposed change in credit has been endorsed by the Life Science Department.
