Re: 0802.532 - Contemporary Elementary Education

The Department of Elementary Education would like to change the credits given for 0802.532 - Contemporary Elementary Education from 3 - 6 credits to 1 - 6 credits. The Department feels that there would be a demand for portions of the present course if the credits could be offered separately for fewer credits than now are given. A range of 1 - 6 credits would more appropriately provide for the intended offering.

Such flexibility would facilitate the achievement of stated department goals:

1. To provide for the advanced preparation of elementary school teachers through a program which aims to provide for preparation and penetrations for teaching beyond that achieved in undergraduate education.
2. To provide a limited number of elective courses that will allow for development of a more diverse program.
3. To provide innovative techniques that will enhance the skills of programs and in-service elementary teachers and improve the learning situation for early childhood and elementary school populations.

We have consulted with Dr. Lawson Brown and he has encouraged us to see this change. Original application for this change was made to the committee in a similar communication dated May 2, 1974. We would appreciate speedy consideration of this request.
