2. Rationale

a. There was, apparently, a typographical error in the initial proposal that created these prerequisites. The hegis number for Management Information Systems must have been incorrectly stated as 0704.333 when it should have been stated as 0702.334. (Note that there is no course with the hegis number 0704.333.) Our advisement sheet (showing the course names without numbers) is attached to show that this was the original intent.)

b. There is no curricular effect. This is the set of prerequisites that was desired all along and for which faculty currently advise.
