1. Details:

a. Change Requested: Change credits from 12 semester hours to variable credit (1-12 semester hours). Change course description

b. Sponsors: Educational Leadership Department

2. Rationale

a. Statement of need for change: The original design of the doctoral program required students to register for 4, 6, or 12 semester hours of dissertation credit within one calendar year following approval of the proposal. While the intent was to support timely completion of the dissertation, the current structure does not allow for continuing enrollment for ~~students~~ who will utilize more than one year to write the dissertation. Variable credit will allow ~~students~~ to enroll in a minimum of 1 credit of 0824.795 until they have successfully completed and defended the dissertation. This adjustment will not alter the 12 hour minimum credit requirement for the dissertation.

3. Statement of curricular effect: There is no curricular effect

4. Results of consultation: This minor curriculum change is supported by the curriculum committee, the faculty, and the chairperson of the Department of Educational Leadership. This change has no effect on any other program since the Educational Leadership program offers the only doctorate.

Catalog Description

This is a 12 credit independent research project to be conducted in conformity with the student's dissertation proposal that has been approved by the student's doctoral committee. Students may register for between 1 and 12 credits of dissertation research and must maintain continuous enrollment (fall and spring semesters) until the dissertation has been accepted by the doctoral committee. Dissertations must be completed within three calendar years of passage of the second benchmark.

This is to advise you that that, at our department meeting on February 22, 2000, the Educational Leadership approved the following proposals for curricular changes:

- (1) Proposed minor curriculum change: Change prerequisites for selected courses in the administrative track within the M.A. in Higher Education
- (2) Proposed minor curriculum change: Additions and deletions of selected courses within the elective bank of the specialization in mathematics in the instructional track within the M.A. in Higher Education
- (3) Proposed major curriculum change: Updating the curriculum (including the development of new courses) of the specialization in computer science within the M.A. in Higher Education
- (4) Proposed minor curriculum change: Change in the credit designation for the course entitled *Dissertation Research in Educational Leadership (0824.795)* **from** 12 s.h. **to** variable credit 1-12 s.h. and an accompanying change in the catalog course description.
- (5) Proposed new course: *Leading the Learning Centered School (3.s.h.)*
