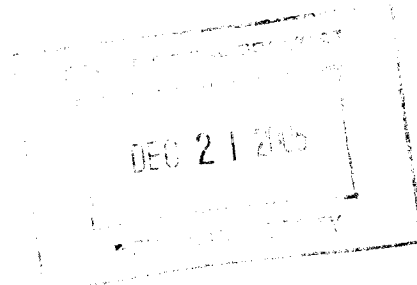

RATIONALE

a. Need for changes:

Title: The term “electronic journalism” now refers to Web journalism, which is not the focus of the course. “Broadcast journalism” is the current term used. In addition, “newscast” further clarifies the activities of the course.

Prerequisite: Students are using high-end, sophisticated equipment in this course, and taking TV Production I will help them become proficient in using this equipment.

b. Curricular effects: The title change will have no curricular effect other than to clarify the course name. The prerequisite change will have a positive curricular effect in that students will know how to use the equipment more efficiently than before.

TITLE CHANGES

The Journalism Department has discussed and unanimously agreed to change the titles of five of our Journalism courses. The title changes more accurately describe the content of the courses. Four of these courses were originally titled many years ago; the new titles reflect the current terminology.
