Minor curriculum change proposal

Prerequisite change

1. Details

- a. Change prerequisites for the three End-User Computing Courses (0702.210, 0702.211, and 0702.212) **from** Computer Literacy (0701.100) **to** Computing Environments (0701.200).
- b. Sponsor: Joel Rudin, Department of Management/MIS

2. Rationale

- a. The university approves Computing Environments but not Computer Literacy as part of the General Education requirement (see 1998-2000 Undergraduate Catalog, page 34). Therefore, if we do not make this minor curriculum change, our students will have to take a course from the Computer Science department that does not satisfy their General Education requirements. Furthermore, since Computer Literacy or its equivalent is a prerequisite for Computing Environments (see 1998-2000 Undergraduate Catalog, page 169), this proposed change will increase the likelihood that our students will succeed in the End-User Computing Courses.
- b. There is no curricular effect on our department. If we were not to make this change, the Computer Science department would have to staff additional sections of Computer Literacy for our students, many of whom would be able to successfully complete the Computing Environments course.

3. Results of Consultation

This proposal was discussed and unanimously approved at a meeting of the Department of Management/MIS.
